**MAY 06** Departure from Toronto to Gdansk.

**MAY 07** Arrival, time to rest, meet and greet cocktail party before dinner. Dinner and overnight in Gdansk.

**MAY 08** After breakfast we start our visit with **Gdansk** situated on the Baltic Sea, the amber capital and home of Solidarity movement. Enjoy a guided walk through the Old Town, discover Dlugi Targ and fabulous Mariacka Street. Your next stop will be **Sopot**, a famous spa resort best known for its Europe's longest wooden pier. Dinner and overnight in Gdansk.

**MAY 09** Today we leave Gdansk and travel to Warsaw. En route we stop in **Malbork**. We visit world's largest brick gothic castle. Founded in the Middle Ages by the Teutonic Knights it still enchants with splendour and beauty. The guide will lead you through the dormitories, the Great Refectory, the Master's Chamber, and the Church of Our Lady. Continue to **Warsaw** for dinner and overnight.

**MAY 10** We start our day with visit to the Lazienki Garden with its beautiful Palace on the Isle and the Chopin Monument. Panoramic tour of Warsaw includes Palace of Culture and Science, the Royal Route and the National Opera. In the afternoon visit to the Old Town. Completely destroyed during the Second World War it was rebuilt so precisely that in 1980 it was inscribed on the UNESCO Heritage List. We see The Royal Castle and the Barbican, old city walls. Some free time for shopping. Dinner (on your own) in one of many restaurants in the city. Overnight in Warsaw.

**MAY 11** Today we travel from Warsaw to **Cracow**. In the afternoon we start our tour of Cracow, the ancient capital of Poland with visit to the Wawel Hill and Wawel Castle, for centuries the residence of the kings of Poland and the symbol of Polish statehood. We also see The Wawel Cathedral, main burial site for Polish monarchs since the 14th century. Dinner and overnight in Cracow.

**MAY 12** Today we start our day with a visit to the famous Salt Mines of Wieliczka, a splendid 3-mile long underground complex of chambers, chapels and statues sculpted from salt. In the afternoon we continue tour of Cracow. We visit the Market Place, St Mary's Church with the extraordinary Wit Stwosz altar. The surroundings of the square have remained unchanged for almost 700 years and contain buildings of historic value such as the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall and the Collegium Maius, the oldest building of the Jagiellonian University which is a gem of 15th century Gothic architecture. We also discover Kazimierz - Cracow's historic Jewish quarter, now a jumble of indie galleries, quirky shops, vintage clothing stores and bars. Dinner and overnight in Cracow.

**MAY 13** Today we start our day with a visit to Auschwitz, the notorious Nazi Concentration camp. We will see the cell that imprisoned St Maximilian Kolbe and the Martyrdom Museum recalling the horrors of the Holocaust. In the afternoon continue to Zakopane, winter capital of Poland. Folklore dinner and overnight in Zakopane.

**MAY 14** Enjoy relaxing day in **Zakopane**, picturesquely situated at the foot of the Tatra Mountains. You will fall in love with beautifully decorated wooden houses and magnificent panoramic views of the Tatra Mountains. Dinner and overnight in Zakopane.

**MAY 15** In the morning we are transferred back to Cracow. Afternoon free at leisure for last minute shopping. Farewell dinner (on your own) at the famous Wierzynek Restaurant, with 14th-century royal origins and decor including armor, knights' sabers and stained glass. The menu is based on the traditional feasting habits of the Polish monarchy, but it hasn't failed to adopt modern influences as well, meaning you'll eat like a king and remember the experience - one you could only have in Cracow - for quite a long time.

**MAY 16** Departure from Cracow to Toronto.
