
# ADVOCATING FOR YOU

---

The Milton Chamber brings business and community leaders together to advocate at all levels of government for policies that further enhance Milton's prosperity.

In 2025, we advocated for:

## FREE TRADE



Free trade came into sharp focus in 2025, with the imposition of wide sweeping tariffs affecting global commerce. As efforts to negotiate tariffs were underway, consideration of internal trade barriers that prevent interprovincial trade within Canada came into sharper focus. The Milton Chamber has long advocated (for decades) for free trade between provinces, as it improves the movement of people and goods throughout Canada.

At a time where trade was weakened with the United States, we were pleased to see both the Provincial and Federal governments make a series of sweeping moves to eliminate longstanding trade barriers between and among Canadian provinces. Ontario has since signed memorandums of understanding with 10 of 12 other provinces and territories to boost interprovincial trade. The Government of Canada announced the removal of more than half of federal exceptions to the Canadian Free Trade Agreement, in order to strengthen interprovincial trade. These are steps in the right direction and long overdue.



## POST SECONDARY EDUCATION

The Milton Chamber joined the Ontario Chamber of Commerce, Colleges Ontario, and the Council of Ontario Universities' call for the provincial government to invest in talent, innovation, and economic resilience. We flagged the financial crisis facing our post-secondary institutions, forcing them to make decisions that could compromise the quality of education in Ontario and limit our ability to attract and retain a talented workforce.



## BETTER PUBLIC TRANSIT

As part of our ongoing advocacy for improved public transit to service businesses and customers, the Milton Chamber of Commerce joined the call for transit funding to include predictable operational funding to municipalities for transit operations, in addition to simply supporting capital funding for fleet expansion.

For public transit fleets to grow, fleet purchases are only part of the puzzle; supporting operational funding is key to unlocking better transit in Milton and beyond. We successfully proposed a policy resolution to support this position across the Provincial chamber network.




